REDO Procedure

When there is a need to complete a Redo of a homework assignment, the student is to:

- make their corrections on a separate sheet of paper
- showing all work
- staple it to the **FRONT** of the assignment with:
 - The full heading (Name, Date, Class, Lesson)
 - REDO largely written on it

If Redos do not have these items or not in this order, I will place a large **?** and the student needs to make corrections.

I will **not** input the updated score until this is followed to encourage students to have attention to details.

Grading System

- Homework Assignments – Used as practice and reinforcement of skills taught (2 pts per assignment)
 - Must be done completely, on time and with work shown neatly on graph paper
 - No work = no credit - calculators are only used to CHECK an answer NOT GET the answer
 - Problem corrections are required on papers with less than an 80% (score of 1 pt)
 - Redo of all problems on appears below 60% - **grade is a zero until REDO is turned in**
 - **Students have 2 school nights to complete the Redos** after that time frame they will not be accepted since each lesson builds on each other to develop skills needed to make progress in the curriculum.
 - Papers are to be folded in half vertically and problems worked down the paper in two columns
 - Students that **arrive late** to class and thus late to grading homework will lose .5 pts for that assignment that **cannot** be made up for a max points of 1.5 for that assignment.
- Tests – approximately 4-6 per quarter (**40 pts each**)
 - 20 questions per test (2 pts per question)
 - All work must be shown to receive full credit
- Participation - students earn **1 pt per day** of class for participation. Students are expected to engage in classroom discussion with thoughtful dialogue. Students can lose more than 1 pt on a day for multiple infractions. (Ex- they may lose 2 points for not having their book covered and for misspeaking in class).
- Notebook – (**20 pts per quarter**)
 - Take notes daily in your notebook
 - Keep all graded homework, math info, tests and quizzes for the semester in your notebook for review.

Middle School Grade Scale

A = 90 – 100%
B = 80 – 89 %

C = 70 – 79%
D = 60 – 69%

F = 0 – 59%

PRAXI Comments:

There is a comment section for all assignments when looking at PRAXI. I *leave* all comments so there is a record of the student's performance for each assignment. The *score* is updated to reflect completion of assignments. These are what the various comments mean:

- **If there is no comment, then the student has completed that assignment and earned an 80% or above and logged at 2 points.**

- **“Incomplete”** - work was not complete enough to warrant grading the assignment - it is now considered late and max points for the assignment is 1 pt.

- **“Missing”** - the student did not turn in the assignment on the day it was due therefore the student is missing the assignment until it is turned in. At this point, the most the student can earn is 1 point

- **“No work”** - there are too many problems without work shown to warrant credit and max points for the assignment is 1 pt.

- “**Redo**” - the student earned less than an 80% on the assignment and needs to redo the questions they did incorrectly
- “**Less than 60%**” - the student earned less than 60% on the homework assignment and need to redo the ENTIRE assignment including the ones that were correct in order to practice the content.
- “**abs**” - the student was absent that day and needs to make up that assignment by following the absent policy
- “**(date-?)**” - the student attempted to turn in an assignment but failed to follow the REDO procedure explained above

SUMMARY:

Homework assignments have a MAX score of 2 points

- REDOS will **only be accepted after 2 school nights** to be prepared for further content and tests
- If they score below 80% on any homework assignment they earned only 1 point until they complete their REDOS
- If they score below a 60% on any homework assignment they earned 0 points until they complete their REDOS and they must redo the **ENTIRE** assignment, not just the questions they missed.

- When REDOS are completed correctly, the score is updated to a max of 2 points

NOTE: Students can earn 100% on homework assignments if they COMPLETE THEIR REDOS ON TIME

Tests have a MAX total of 40 points

They are roughly after every 5th lesson, typically on Wednesdays

There are **NO REDOS for tests** - their score is their score.

Binder checks have a MAX score of 20 points.

Participation have MAX score of 1 point for every class day.
